Regulation (EU) 305/2011



The Construction Products Regulation

Regulation (EU) 305/2011 "The Construction Products Regulation" requires that each construction product, for which a harmonised European standard (hEN) or European Technical Assessment (ETA) exists has a Declaration of Performance (DoP) and is affixed with a CE Mark before it can be placed on the Single Market. Always check suitability for end use. The below products are common within agricultural buildings and are manufactured under harmonised European Standards:

- Precast Concrete Products Floor Slats for Livestock I.S. EN 12737:2004+A1:2007
- Steel & Aluminium Structures (Requirements for Conformity Assessment of Structural Components) I.S. EN 1090-1:2009+A1:2011
- Aggregate Concrete Blocks I.S. EN 771-3:2011+A1:2015. Refer also to: A Guide to the Marketing and Use of Aggregate Concrete Blocks to EN 771-3 in Ireland.

Economic Operators must make available the Declaration of Performance for these products to the End User. These products must also have an affixed CE Mark or accompanying documentation regarding CE Marking. The National Standards Authority of Ireland (www.nsai.ie) & Irish Steel (www.irishsteel.ie) websites include registers of Economic Operators who have been audited to supply these products.
